Footnotes

LONDIINIUM sent hard to the front in the early stages, saved ground setting the pace, opened up on the backstretch and held sway under steady handling. R S WATSON four wide into the first turn, chased outside then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly. LICO angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and bested the others. DUKE STREET KING between foes early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CALCULATED CHAOS angled in before the first turn and saved ground throughout to no avail. HARLINGTON NIGHT stalked the winner three deep then off the rail or outside on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. LOUISTHEFIFTEENTH well placed stalking the pace between horses, dropped back outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
