Footnotes

BIG WAGS saved ground inside two rivals around the first turn, dueled outside a foe down the backstretch and into the second turn, inched away from that foe leaving the quarter pole and remained clear to the wire under urging. JOE CARL was unhurried on the inside into the first turn, chased along the rail down the backstretch and around the second turn, came out at the top of the stretch, angled back towards the rail in midstretch, rallied along the rail in the final furlong, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. COOK INLET chased on the outside down the backstretch and around the second turn, came into the lane three wide, improved his position in the final furlong and gained the show on the wire. BOBBY HANDY was between horses around the first turn, stalked inside a foe on the backstretch, fell back some into the second turn, came into the stretch between horses and was edged for the show on the wire. SMOKIN' CAT angled in to save ground around the first turn, moved up leaving the turn to duel for the lead inside the winner down the backstretch and into the second turn, could not match strides leaving the quarter pole, came outside the winner in midstretch and weakened. HOOSIER DIDDY was sent along to duel for the lead three deep into the first turn, stalked three and four wide down the backstretch, weakened between horses on the second turn and gave way in the lane.
