## Footnotes

APPEALING RESUME stalked the pace inside to the stretch, came out for room bumping ADDENDUM in midstretch, gained the lead outside the pacesetter in deep stretch and proved best under steady handling. WITH A MIRACLE had speed off the rail then angled in, dueled inside, inched away into and on the turn, fought back along the fence in deep stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. ADDENDUM stalked outside a rival or off the rail, moved up three deep on the turn, angled in entering the stretch, continued between horses, drifted in a bit and bumped with the winner then was steadied in midstretch and held third. SCARY RIDE stalked outside then three deep, advanced four wide on the turn and three wide into the stretch, was bumped in midstretch and was outfinished for third. ELVIES LANE angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked on the turn and weakened in the stretch. INNER GROOVE between horses early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail into and on the turn and lacked the needed rally. BROOKLYN ROSE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. CEE'S THE YEAR angled in and settled inside chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. ROSSI RESERVE was unsettled, tried to rear and was away well behind the field, went up four wide on the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside and three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run in midstretch between the first and third finishers but made no change when they ruled both runners contributed to the contact between them.
