RIDE AND SHINE settled a bit off the rail on the backstretch, began to advance toward the inside leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up late. OUR NEW RECRUIT went up inside to duel for command, inched clear past midstretch but was caught at the wire. BIG APPLE chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and closed gamely. LA BANDERA had good early speed and dueled three deep to midstretch, then weakened late. THE GRIFF prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch, stalked off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, was crowded off the winner's heels in midstretch and lacked a further response. R MEADOW LUCK dueled between horses to midstretch, dropped back and weakened. FANCY M. D. stumbled badly at the start to drop well back, angled in and saved ground but was outrun.
