OLIGARCH sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, drifted out some in the stretch but held on gamely under urging. CAUSEITHERTZ settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out for room into the stretch and finished willingly. SILENTIO angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in midstretch and also went on willingly to save the show. GAB POWER settled inside then went between foes on the backstretch, dropped back and angled in on the second turn, remained inside in the stretch and finished with interest. MAYBE TUESDAY pulled between horses early, chased three deep, went between foes again on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MASSONE angled in and settled outside a rival then three deep into and on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SEATTLE RULER close up stalking the pace off the rail to the stretch, weakened in the final furlong. LUMBERYARD JACK stalked between foes then a bit off the rail, went between rivals into and on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. TIME LORD went up to stalk the pace three wide then outside a rival, continued three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
