**Footnotes**

EDDIE'S TURN unhurried outside then off the rail, moved up outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging and caught the runner-up late. PRAY HARD went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. SEEKING ASYLUM between horses early, settled a bit off the rail, steadied off heels leaving the turn, angled to the inside, came out and split rivals in midstretch and picked up the show. MAUCO chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AWESOME RETURN settled between horses then off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HE'S A REAL KEEPER broke slowly, settled inside to the stretch, came out in the drive and improved position. CALIFORNIA JADE had speed to stalk the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. PYROTECHNICS broke a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail, came out some in the stretch and failed to menace. FRENHAM angled in and dueled four wide then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, fell back some a quarter mile out

and weakened. MASS TRANSIT angled in and dueled between horses, also fell back a bit leaving the turn, steadied while weakening between foes in midstretch and had little left in the final furlong. STORM THE HEAVENS angled in and dueled three deep between horses, steadied sharply just before the half mile pole, stalked off the rail and weakened in the drive. WHERE'S THE HEAT stalked three wide then off the rail, dropped back leaving the turn, steadied between horses into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
