Footnotes

TAKEM BY SURPRISE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside then inched away into the turn, fought back on the turn and kicked away again a quarter mile out, drew clear under urging while drifting out in the stretch and proved best. SOOO MAJOR broke in, bumped a rival then pulled and steadied early, chased just off the rail, came out into and on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, was bumped in midstretch but gained the show. CAPO chased inside, went around a rival into the stretch then went up the rail in the drive for the show. HITTER'S ALLEY bumped at the start, chased three deep then outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch, was bumped soundly in midstretch and edged for third. MUCK N GRIND bumped at the break, stalked outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, shifted out under left handed pressure to bump a rival in midstretch and lacked the

needed rally. RUN FOR PLEASURE off a bit slowly, settled out from the rail then outside a rival, found the inside in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. GOOD SAMURAI prompted the pace between horses then stalked, bid again outside the winner on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. ILLYBILLY BOY unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MARCUS FURIUS forced the pace three deep then stalked leaving the backstretch and on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. HEAVENLY TRAIL bobbed at the start, settled between horses then outside a rival, continued off the rail then angled in on the turn and did not rally. PAPA SMITTY a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, dropped back leaving the turn, steadied in tight into the stretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping in the stretch but made no change when they ruled MUCH N GRIND was responsible for the trouble.
