FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH ARE NON-WINNERS OF EITHER \$3,000 TWICE OTHER THAN MAIDEN, CLAIMING, STARTER OR NON-WINNER OF THREE. Three-year-olds, 120 lbs. Older, 122 lbs. Non-Winners of two races other than claiming or starter at one mile or over since August 15 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race other than maiden, claiming or starter since then, 4 lbs. (Horses eligible only to the above allowance conditions are preferred.) (Starters for a claiming race of \$25,000 or less in their last three starts and maidens that are non-starters for a claiming price have second preference). Rail at 30 feet. (NW2 X)

MOTTO, came off the rail and went outside a rival to stalk the pace on the backstretch, regained the wood on the second turn, came out to bid outside ONE MAN ARMY, brushed with that one late and gamely prevailed under steady handling. ONE MAN ARMY sped outside rivals to the early lead, angled in, set the pace along the rail, fought back inside the winner and brushed with that one late in a game try. ROUNDABOUT, saved ground close up, dropped back on the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, came out a bit and bested the others. BLUE GRASS BLUES, settled a bit off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. STRODES STATION, broke a bit in the air, stalked three deep, continued close up a bit off the rail and weakened in the stretch. RICO SUAVE (IRE) between rivals early, stalked the pace along the inside and also weakened.
