Footnotes

ONEEXCESSIVENITE pulled her way up outside a rival into the first turn, shook clear into the backstretch, widened her advantage on the second turn while racing just out from the rail and just held under urging. LADY'S MANTLE (IRE) settled off the inside, split horses on the second turn, came out in the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. SIRACOQUE chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. BOND MIDNIGHT (IRE) three wide early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail and lacked a response in the stretch. DOTTED SWISS pulled between horses early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went around a rival in midstretch and was not a threat. LOVE STORM had speed inside the winner early, chased that one along the inside and weakened.
