Footnotes

POHAVE a bit crowded at the start, moved up inside to stalk the pace, came out into the stretch, collared the runner-up past midstretch and pulled clear under urging. LOVE THAT LION went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away a half mile out, turned back bids and inched clear on the turn but could not hold off the winner. GOODNEWS BAY prompted the pace between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and was edged for second. VICTOR SLEW chased outside a rival then three deep early on the turn, angled in off heels leaving the bend and lacked the needed rally. RADIATA prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch, stalked three deep into and on the turn and weakened. FROM A TO Z forced the pace between horses then stalked between rivals, dropped back on the turn and weakened. HIGH TRACKS (BRZ) came in a bit at the start, was allowed to settle inside, drifted out on the turn and gave way.
