LUCKY PRIMO stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, battled outside that one through the final furlong and gamely prevailed under urging. GOT EVEN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and through a long drive and went gamely to the end. JOHN SCOTT a bit slow to begin, stalked three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and continued willingly late. ROUSING SERMON between foes early, stalked inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. WOODMANS LUCK allowed to settle just off the inside then along the fence on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary rally. HOLLADAY ROAD broke a bit slowly, settled inside, went between horses into the second turn, came out three wide into the stretch and did not rally. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET between foes early, was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail then between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
