Footnotes

SETTING THE STAGE settled outside, advanced three wide around the final bend, lugged inward throughout the stretch but was along in time under left hand urging. GOOD TIME BENJI (IRE) prominent early from along the rail, swung out and loomed into the lane, drifted inward nearing midstretch, gained a brief lead but could not stave off the winner. GOOD JOURNEY unhurried from the inside, angled out and split foes around the second turn and finished very willingly from the outside. DEPARTURE was hard to load, stepped to the front while securing the rail, set all the pace to the stretch, drifted out approaching midstretch and weakened late. INFANTRY angled to the rail, saved ground throughout and passed tiring rivals. DYNA KING was off tardily, angled over to save some ground, raced off the rail and never menaced. GAZE AT ME stalked the pacesetter while saving ground but had little left for the drive. EL TEMPRANILLO (IRE) advanced steadily from along the rail into the stretch, loomed boldly nearing midstretch but was squeezed, clipped heels and then forced to steady sharply, then was taken in hand late and gave way. CORPORATE SALE raced two wide early, then three wide around the final bend, five wide into the stretch and never challenged. Following a stewards inquiry into the incident in the stretch, GOOD TIME BENJI was disqualified and placed seventh for drifting inward, and DEPARTURE was disqualified and placed eighth for drifting out in the drive.
