Footnotes

HYDER saved ground chasing the leaders, swung out into the stretch and rallied gamely under urging. TREASURED NOTE tracked the pace a bit off the rail, was blocked off heels leaving the turn, found room into the stretch and rallied between foes late. AMERICAN PASTIME broke out a bit, dueled inside, inched away past midstretch but could not hold off the top pair. NICK (CHI) chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and went willingly to the end. JOOPY DOOPY dueled between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. BRIGADE prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
