Footnotes

TWIN SIX prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear in the drive, drifted out some and held under left handed urging. MAGNUM FORCE saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and rallied between foes late. SHARP RICHARD stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split foes in midstretch and also rallied while between horses late. SCORCHER pulled his way along to chase a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. RANSOM CANYON a bit washy at the gate, broke a step slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace and ran up along the rail through the stretch. VERY ELUSIVE (IRE) broke a bit slowly, chased between foes then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. COPPER BAY five wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival, also came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRIBAL SMOKE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. AFFLICATION angled in and stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also weakened. WARREN'S BIG CAT four wide through the first turn, chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened. MR. ORNER pulled between horses then angled in

and chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
