Footnotes

TIZNOW grabbed quick control and secured the rail, deftly rated to the final bend, remained inside when challenged and repulsed rival through a prolonged stretch duel while inching away late under strong hand pressure. CAPTAIN STEVE content to stalk the pacesetter a bit off the rail to the final bend, under a ride late on the turn, loomed menacingly nearing the eighth marker, nearly got on even terms a sixteenth out but could not get by late. EUCHRE forwardly place from the inside to the final turn, dropped back a bit late on the bend, then angled out passing midstretch and finished very willingly. SIR BEAR settled three wide around both bends and failed to mount any stretch response. BIG TEN (CHI) content to track the leader while three wide, continued outside before angling to the rail early in the stretch and failed to menace. RIVER KEEN (IRE) reserved from along the rail, moved up a bit around the second turn, then swung out for room and raced four wide into the stretch but never challenged. BAGSHOT unhurried from between rivals early, later raced four wide around he final bend and was outrun from the far outside in the stretch.
