Footnotes

DELL PLACE saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, angled out into the stretch, waited behind rivals then split foes in midstretch and rallied inside under urging to collar SPECIAL RATE in deep stretch and held gamely. GRAFTON chased outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and closed gamely. SPECIAL RATE stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, bid three deep into and on the second turn, gained the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, could not quite match the top pair late but held third. GOLDEN ARROW chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. BILLY'S ECHO sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BIS REPETITAS angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WILD BABE pulled early, stalked off the rail, bid between horses into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the drive.
