**Footnotes**

TEARDROPS ON FIRE stalked a bit off the rail then between foes, continued inside on the turn and into the stretch, came out past midstretch to brush a rival, surged to the front under some urging three deep and won clear. COURAGEOUSANDBOLD sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch, could not match the winner but held second. WARREN'S MORGAN also sent along early, dueled outside the runner-up, was between foes in deep stretch and held third. FIRE WISE angled in and stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, brushed with the winner in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. LADY ARAGORN stalked four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. DUALITY came in at the start, stalked between foes then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn, drifted inward in the stretch and weakened. PLAYING DIRTY steadied when crowded at the start, settled off the rail, came out in the stretch and was not a factor. SEA OF JOY between foes early, chased a bit off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. JESSAKAR steadied when crowded at the start and steadied again in the early going, pulled her way between rivals to stalk the pace, continued outside on the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
