JAYLO MARINO prompted the pace outside a rival, took the lead leaving the turn, drifted out into the stretch, kicked clear under urging, drifted in some and held sway. STAR NICHOLAS settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished well. DEPUTIFORMER chased off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and bested the others. CAPTURE THE CALL a bit crowded by the riderless horses early, chased outside, went four wide into the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DIXIE TROUPER stalked inside, came out on the turn, waited briefly when hemmed in a bit by the riderless runner into the stretch, angled inward in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. LORD AVALON settled outside then off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, cut the corner into the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch, came out and could not summon the necessary response. DERRICK DO had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, came out slightly then drifted inward in midstretch and weakened. SUMMERS AT DELMAR stumbled badly at the start and unseated the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling SUMMERS AT DELMAR was the cause of his own trouble.
