ULTIMATE EAGLE tugged a bit and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear on the second turn, continued clear in the stretch and held on well under urging. VENOMOUS (GB) unhurried inside until nearing the stretch, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly between horses while bumping with a rival late. COZY KITTEN squeezed a bit just after the start, angled in and settled outside a rival then inside, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and also rallied willingly between foes. MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE pulled his way along and angled in early, prompted the pace between foes, stalked on the second turn, was between horses again into the stretch, went on willingly in the drive but lacked the needed late kick and was bumped late. CLOUD MAN chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. THERESMYEVERYTHING between foes early, angled in and stalked inside to the stretch, continued toward the rail and lacked the needed late kick. SURREY STAR (IRE) angled in four wide early then pressed the pace three deep, stalked three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. LIL BIT O'FUN settled toward the inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. AKKADIAN was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival or between foes, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.

THIRTYFIRSTSTREET bumped at the start, chased outside a rival then inside on the backstretch and second turn, split horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally toward the fence. DREAMY KID broke awkwardly and was bumped, went up three deep on the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GREAT WARRIOR (BRZ) came out in the run to the first turn, chased three deep then off the rail on the second turn, angled in some and weakened. ARRAIGNMENT broke slowly and was bumped, saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a factor. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY well placed stalking the leaders along the inside, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE against the runner-up for alleged interference in late stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the bumping incident did not alter the original order of finish.
