SENIOR RAIN pulled his way to the front and lugged out a bit into the first turn, angled in and dueled inside, inched away briefly into the second turn, battled along the rail leaving that turn, inched clear again into the stretch and proved best under urging. INQUISITIVE SON had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and edged a rival late for second. QUALITY ELUSION three deep into the first turn, prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked into the second turn, bid again alongside that rival leaving that turn, was not a match for that foe in the stretch and lost the place late. NEBIKON stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S CLYDE broke a step slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail, came out in upper stretch then drifted in and did not rally. ENUFF BULL angled in on the first turn then came out on the backstretch to chase the pace, went three deep into the stretch and could not summon the needed response. HANDSOME HARVEY JR three wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, was between foes into the stretch and weakened.
