Footnotes

UP IN TIME (GB) three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up, gained the lead under urging past midstretch and inched away late. CELESTIAL KITTEN close up stalking the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the leader on the second turn, took the advantage into the stretch, fought back inside the winner in the final furlong, could not match that one late but held second between foes. BAUBLE QUEEN chased inside then a bit off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. IMPERIALISTIC DIVA (IRE) had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit into the stretch, went around a rival in deep stretch and finished with interest inside. SARAH'S SECRET stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. ENTRUSTMENT saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and was outfinished. GLOWING SPIRIT (BRZ) settled three deep or outside a rival, went three wide leaving the backstretch and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CATHY'S CRUNCHES angled in and settled a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and into the stretch and also lacked the needed rally. TALES IN EXCESS had speed outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn and into the stretch, dropped back in the final furlong, steadied when rivals went by a sixteenth out and weakened. GOING FOR A SPIN chased between horses or outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ROSEHILL DEW (IRE) broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, angled in and pulled her way along inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed

response in the drive.
