Footnotes

LEXINGTON BEACH broke slowly, angled in early, settled off the inside, moved up outside on the second turn and wide into the stretch but rallied to the front past midstretch and just held off DANCING MAJESTY, then collapsed on the backstretch after and was vanned off. DANCING MAJESTY rank inside early, moved up into the second turn but waited while blocked on that bend, got through into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and rallied gamely inside. COMPANY APPROVAL off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn, swung out in upper stretch and closed gamely. RONCESVALLES settled outside, moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, put a head in front between rivals in midstretch but weakened late. ECONOMIC TREND settled off the inside, was boxed in off heels on the second turn but could not offer the needed rally when clear. DEL RAY DEVIL three deep on the first turn, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, then weakened. PICK UP STICKS angled in early and stalked the pace, took a short lead inside into the second turn but also weakened in the stretch. DIXIE THRILL saved ground, dropped back into the second turn and gave way. CHARISMATIC sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled briefly outside PICK UP STICKS into the second turn, then stopped.
