Footnotes

GULSARY (IRE) reserved from inside then stalked while bit off the fence, advanced three wide into the lane then struck the front approaching mid-stretch, edged away and safely prevailed under confident handling. LADY ASANO angled over early and was content to chase the pace from the inside, shifted out around the second bend, came four wide into the stretch and finished strongly while outside winner. LIFE IS A STONE quickly established control, set the pace from the inside, fought back from the inside leaving the turn but relinquished control nearing the eighth marker and lasted for third. ENGLISH CROSSING prompted the early pace then advanced and grabbed brief lead passing quarter and entering the stretch, could not go with the winner and weakened in the drive. PERFECTA raced outside eventual winner to last bend, was fanned four four then five wide around that bend and into the stretch and did not threaten late. DISKO DASKO (FR) pulled hard along the inside into the backstretch, was in tight nearing five-eighths marker, finally, settled, chased inside and weakened.
