TAMARACK BAY settled off the rail, split horses with a move forward on the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up while drifting in late. ILE DE FRANCE prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear past midstretch and just failed to hold off the winner. ISSAQUEENA stalked the pace between horses then outside a rival, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, steadied in tight behind the winner late and could not offer the needed response. EXPRESSWAY saved ground close up stalking the pace and lacked the necessary late kick. SMART LACY hopped in a slow start, went outside a rival on the first turn, continued a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and improved position. HAPPY MICHELLE sped to the early lead, dueled inside, fought back in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. RENAISSANCE WOMAN was in a good position chasing four wide to the stretch and lacked a further response. SUGAR FREE five wide into the first turn, settled outside chasing the pace, went three deep on the second turn and five wide again into the stretch and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident involving the first and third runners in deep stretch but made no change when the ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
