Footnotes

SHEZSOFOXY unhurried a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in approaching the turn, then rallied along the inside under urging in the stretch to prove narrowly best. RUBIN'S ROSE had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid outside the leader in the drive, gained a short advantage past midstretch, fought back to the wire and narrowly missed. SAXONY chased inside, swung out into the stretch and continued willingly three deep at the wire. LIL BIT DEVILISH dueled off the rail but inside a rival on the backstretch, angled in some and kicked clear on the turn, fought back nearing midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. DARLIN BARBIE chased three deep between horses on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FORTY SI (ARG) chased five wide on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and was not a threat. STAGE DOWN chased four wide on the backstretch, angled in and dropped back on the turn and did not rally. SEVENS WILD was in a good position tracking the leaders between horses on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. A LIL EXCESS had good early speed outside then dueled outside a rival, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
