Footnotes

ISLE OF PRADO chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. SYNCOBEAT chased inside, split horses on the backstretch, went up three deep into and on the second turn, angled in some nearing the stretch, rallied to a short lead in deep stretch and just failed to hold off the winner. GOTHIC SAMURAI (AUS) four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn, took the advantage into the stretch, inched away briefly in midstretch, lugged inward through the final furlong, steadied in late stretch and was overtaken nearing the wire. COLUDA had good early speed and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail, fought back inside GOTHIC SAMURAI past midstretch, was in a bit tight when crowded by that one twice in deep stretch and weakened late. SHEM stalked between horses then off the rail, angled to the inside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. J P JAMMER was in a good position stalking the pace inside then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, weakened some in the drive.
