SEA RASCAL chased between horses, split rivals on the turn, angled in entering the stretch, came out in midstretch, gained the advantage under some left handed urging outside a rival nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear. SOUTHERN STYLE settled between foes early then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and just got second. HIDDEN BLESSING had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back in the stretch, inched away from his pace rival past the eighth pole, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth and was edged late for the place. DAVE'S

PACEMAKER dropped back outside then off the rail, angled in into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. SILENCIO GATO stalked off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch and outside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SIR HAMILTON had speed outside foes then stalked five wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. DISTINCTIVE DUDE had good early speed and stalked between rivals then off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. AMERICAN WILDCAT sent between horses early, dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. LUCKY FITZ sent between horses, settled just off the rail, steadied midway on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. CHOP HOUSE GEORGE chased inside, steadied in tight behind the pulling up horse and came out midway on the turn and did not rally. OL'DOGTOWN chased between horses then three deep into the turn, dropped back off the rail and gave way. MACK'S GOLD BULLET angled in and stalked inside, pulled up sharply on the turn but walked off.
