BROKEN DREAMS stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out some in the stretch and rallied under urging and strong handling to get up between foes late. KINDLE sped to the early lead, opened a clear advantage and angled in, set the pace inside and held on well but was caught late. BYRAMA (GB) in a bit tight between foes just after the start, angled in and settled inside, came out in upper stretch and again nearing midstretch and finished well three deep on the line. GIVINE (FR) pulled her way between horses then chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the hill, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. TERODA saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the hill, split horses into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. BRIECAT settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. NINTH INFANTRY chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not offer the necessary late kick. MISS MITTAGONG chased three deep, dropped back leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
