Footnotes

EARLY FLYER sent between horses early, dueled inside until past midstretch, then inched clear under left handed urging. THE GRIFF chased five wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and just got the place. DAUNTING sent between horses and dueled outside the winner to deep stretch, then could not match that one and lost second late. TRUSTEE was sent between rivals early but dropped back off the rail without early speed, came out into the stretch, lacked room off heels briefly in upper stretch, then finished with some interest. JAGUARMEANPASSION chased four wide between foes on the backstretch, continued between foes on the turn and weakened. RECREATION sent between foes early, angled in and chased along the inside on the backstretch and turn and lacked a response in the stretch. LITE UP THE KNIGHT saved ground, dropped back some on the turn, came out in midstretch and also lacked a response. LUCKY MISTER K was in good position chasing the leaders between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn and weakened. WALLAHATCHIE settled outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
