### Footnotes

MAN CHESTER MAN prompted the pace outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, took the lead and inched away on that bend, kicked clear under some urging in the stretch and proved best. NORTH FORK steadied in tight early, stalked between foes or a bit off the rail, was in a bit tight midway on the backstretch, split horses into the stretch and just held second. DUNSCOMBE four wide into the first turn, chased off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. RAINGEAR between foes early, stalked outside then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and weakened. CAPT. SPARROW chased outside then alongside a rival on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EXUMA had speed inside to duel for the lead, battled between horses leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, tracked between foes leaving that turn and weakened. OH HOW NICE a step slow to begin, settled off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and was not a threat. MIND THE MINISTER saved ground stalking the pace, went up inside on the backstretch to duel for the lead and put a head in front, battled along the fence early on the second turn, fell back some in a bit tight leaving that bend and had little left for the stretch, then was vanned off after returning to be unsaddled. NITRO ACTIVE steadied in tight between foes early, settled off the rail, angled to the inside for the second turn and lacked a further response.
