Footnotes

YES IT'S SNOWING sent between horses early, duelled just off the rail then inside, inched away on the turn and held on gamely under urging. THE BLACK

stalked outside then three deep into the turn, continued outside leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and finished willingly. D'WILDBUNCH had speed between rivals then stalked a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out into the stretch, drifted in late and just held third. MON COEUR broke slowly, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went around foes in the drive then continued toward the inside, came out in deep stretch and just missed the show. CRIMSON GIANT steadied when squeezed at the start, drifted out early, swung four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. THE BIEN'S GIFT chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HONEYCOMB broke slowly, settled inside, came out in upper stretch and improved position but was not a threat. SWISS GUARD chased outside a rival then inside, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SARANGANI broke in and bumped a rival, settled outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a response. AMERICAN WARRIOR sent inside to stalk the pace, lugged out and steadied early on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S BANDIT stalked three deep then outside a rival, angled in on the turn and also weakened. RUN CHARLIE RUN allowed to settle outside then off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. RIDE CAPTAIN had speed outside then dueled alongside the winner, stalked on the turn, drifted inward in the stretch and gave way.
