COMMA TO THE TOP sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn, remained clear under urging past midstretch and held on gamely. TRES BORRACHOS saved ground stalking the winner, came out in upper stretch and went on willingly between horses late. JAYCITO broke a bit slowly, pulled his way along toward the inside then came out into the first turn, stalked three deep then off the rail, continued alongside the runner-up on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and also went willingly late three wide on the wire. SHAUN WASHINGTON also a bit slow to begin, pulled early and was fanned four wide into the first turn, angled in a bit off the rail chasing the pace, found the fence on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response. RIVETING REASON stalked outside a rival then between horses, continued alongside a foe on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the second turn and weakened.
