AWKWARD MONDAYS had speed outside then stalked four wide, went three deep between horses into the turn, continued between foes then a bit off the rail leaving the bend, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch, gained a short advantage under left handed urging nearing the wire and prevailed. GOODBYE CHARLIE sped to the early lead outside foes then inched away and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, fought back along the fence through the final furlong and went willingly to the wire. ON HOLY GROUND chased off the rail then outside, went four wide into the turn, continued three deep midway on the bend and outside the winner into the stretch and bested the others. VALEN sent between horses to chase the pace, continued a bit off the rail into and on the turn, angled to the inside in the drive and lacked the needed rally. CORANTO steadied at the start, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out a bit in the stretch and was not a threat. QUICK GENIZAS pulled his way up inside then stalked just off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened. PHILLY SLEW bobbed at the start, settled off the inside, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. WHITE STAR LINE sent between horses to stalk the pace, continued outside a rival or a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. STAR OF AMERICA broke a bit in the air, settled just off the rail, went between horses into the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. DREAM SQUAD chased outside then three deep, dropped back on the turn and gave way. LONESTAR J settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a factor. RAZZBERRY ICE sent inside to stalk the pace, dropped back on the turn and gave way readily.
