JOOPY DOOPY was well placed forcing the pace three deep on the backstretch then outside HERE'S ZEALOUS into the turn, bid four wide leaving the turn and gamely prevailed under urging after a long drive. ORANGEMAN, dueled outside MAGICAL DRAGON then between rivals leaving the turn and to midstretch, continued gamely inside through the final furlong to save second. HERE'S ZEALOUS saved ground just behind the leaders, pulled his way up and waited a bit off heels early on the turn, came off the rail, bid three deep between foes leaving the bend and also went willingly to the end. MAGICAL DRAGON, vied for command along the inside to midstretch and weakened. VALIANT VISION was a bit slow into stride and was outrun early, angled to the rail for the turn, remained inside and lacked the needed rally. CAMERON PASS, also a bit slow into stride, came off the rail leaving the backstretch and was outrun. S
