GIACOMO chased outside a rival, moved up outside a foe then off the rail on the second turn, waited off heels then angled out leaving that turn, swept to the front three deep into the stretch, was pushed along for a couple strides to open up then drew off under a mild hand ride and a long hold. DONNYBROOK PRIDE settled outside a rival then three deep, angled in some on the second turn, came out in the stretch and just got the place. WISE DIPLOMAT chased inside, split horses leaving the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and toward the inside in the stretch and just lost second. MEN ONLY dueled between horses, took the lead past midway on the second turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. CASHMULA dueled inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. TOKEN WILD ONE was in a good position chasing the leaders inside, remained along the rail and weakened. BACKUS was hustled along and angled in early, forced the pace three deep, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
