ISMENE had good early speed and set the pace inside, inched away nearing the half mile pole, kicked clear on the turn and held on gamely under urging. SISTER MOON was a half step slow and a bit awkwardly into stride, settled outside a rival then off the rail, went alongside a foe on the turn and three deep into the stretch and finished willingly but could not catch the winner. EVELYN'S DANCER pulled her way between horses and steadied when bumped and in tight a half mile out, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. LADY PECAN four wide early, stalked three deep, bumped with a rival leaving the backstretch, angled in outside a foe for the turn and weakened in the stretch. NICOS MEMORY saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. LASSO FROM EL PASO pressed the pace between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, was bumped leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
