SO BRILLIANT had good early speed a bit off the rail, inched away a half mile out, dueled alongside a rival on the turn, inched clear into the stretch and proved best under urging. THE ROAN RANGER chased outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. HUSTLIN NU had speed off the rail then outside the winner, stalked three deep leaving the backstretch and into the turn, continued off the inside leaving the turn and into the stretch and was edged for second. OUT OF BOUNDS unhurried outside then off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and bested the others. ZACKN'MAT settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, angled out off heels again past the eighth pole and lacked a rally. VIBRATO JAZZ between horses early, chased off the rail or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. NEUROSURGEON pulled his way along inside and was in a bit tight passing the half mile pole, bid inside the winner to duel for command, came off the fence in upper stretch and weakened. CANDY'S JEWEL close up stalking the pace between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out and fell back into the stretch and also weakened.
