Footnotes

LANDAU, four wide on the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch, took command leaving the second turn and drew off under urging. QUEEN OF KLUGS, bumped between foes and squeezed at the start, saved ground outrun, went around a rival leaving the second turn, angled in late and picked up the place at the wire. SARATOGA ASSASSIN was hustled to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled briefly on the second turn and weakened. IRON DUCHESS, four wide on the first turn, angled in on the backstretch and failed to menace. PRECIOUS DARCY angled in on the first turn when unhurried, came out nearing the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. PEAK AT THIS, forced the pace toward the inside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. CAROLINA MORNING, close up three deep between foes early, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground thereafter and also gave way. TEMPESTUOSO settled off the rail and failed to menace. WHERE'S BOB, broke outward and slowly, raced six wide into the first turn, continued wide and was done upon reaching the second turn.
