Footnotes

SILVER STREET had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, inched clear on the turn and proved best under urging. BELLE GALLANTEY broke a bit slowly, went up between horses on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, went outside a rival leaving the bend, came out into the stretch and gained the place late. WARREN'S WANNA BE three deep early, stalked off the rail or alongside a rival to the stretch and was edged late for second. PURPLE THUNDER prompted the pace inside then stalked along the rail on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and weakened. GANA GATA chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. ADDISON'S HONOR broke a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, took up sharply in tight into the turn, continued along the fence on the bend and did not rally. CROSS THE RIVER stalked four wide then outside a rival on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened.
