### Footnotes

GORGEOUS GOOMAH chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, split foes nearing midstretch, bid inside to gain the lead a sixteenth out and won clear under urging. IRRIDESCENT RED stalked outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch, bid three deep past midstretch and edged a rival for the place. ROMAN CHARITY a bit slow into stride, went up inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and got up late for the show. JUDGE JOAN stalked off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch to gain the lead, inched away in midstretch, was between horses a sixteenth out and was outfinished late for third. FORTY DATES chased off the rail or outside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SAINT CINDY dropped back and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. R. C. STORM had good early speed and dueled inside, battled back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. DUBAI MACAU GIRL bobbled a bit at the start, dueled outside a rival, took a short advantage nearing the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. MOTEL STROLL bobbled sharply at the start, went up outside to chase the pace, fell back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
