Footnotes

LION HEART dueled between horses on the backstretch and into the turn,battled outside a rival on the bend, took a short lead nearing the stretch and gamely prevailed under some urging. BOOMZEEBOOM bobbled at the start, went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch but could not quite match the winner late. PREACHINATTHEBAR stalked between horses then off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside a rival early on the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. SPELLBINDER broke inward, pulled his way along outside on the backstretch, continued outside foes on the turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. MAJOR SUCCESS was in a good position stalking inside on the backstretch and turn, remained along the rail and lacked the needed response. CIGAR PAL four wide early, stalked three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. DWANGO drifted in at the start, settled inside, split horses leaving the turn and was not a threat. FANTASTIC WAGER had brief speed outside then dropped back steadily on the backstretch, raced outside on the turn and wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SAINT AFLEET broke slowly and was squeezed back, went up between horses on the backstretch, angled in off the rail on the turn and weakened. YES had good early speed and angled in to duel three deep, stalked off the rail on the turn and also weakened.
