Footnotes

SELECT FEW came a bit off the rail early and stalked the pace, split rivals into the stretch, gained the lead, kicked clear and held under urging. PRIMARY ACTION wide between rivals early, angled in and moved up on the turn, came out for the stretch and finished well. MORNING STORM was close up between rivals on the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the turn and settled for third. MR. BROAD BLADE raced wide throughout and improved position. STAR SPIRIT close up outside early, was three deep on the turn and weakened. SANDIVORE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside to the stretch and also weakened. FIGHTING FALCON angled in and saved ground to no avail. GOLDEN GENERAL was outrun off the rail and came a bit wide into the stretch. TIMBER BARON was off slowly and squeezed a bit, moved up between rivals on the backstretch but began to weaken on the turn. MACALLAN angled in and saved ground, came out a bit for the stretch and gave way.
