Footnotes

SIX PERFECTIONS (FR) reluctant to load, chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between rivals in deep stretch to gain the lead and proved best under urging. TOUCH OF THE BLUES (FR) unhurried off the rail early, went up three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. CENTURY CITY (IRE) settled between horses, came out in upper stretch, split rivals with a bid in midstretch then rallied toward the inside. IRISH WARRIOR allowed to settle off the rail, circled six wide into the stretch and closed willingly. SOARING FREE stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short advantage nearing midstretch but was overtaken. FREEFOURINTERNET angled in and

saved ground, swung out off heels into the stretch, was in tight between foes in midstretch and could not offer the needed late kick. DESIGNED FOR LUCK had speed outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead leaving that bend but weakened in the final furlong. SPECIAL RING angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, was in a bit tight in upper stretch then steadied hard off heels in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. PERFECT SOUL (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and lacked a further response. OASIS DREAM (GB) pulled his way along early, angled in and chased between horses and weakened in the stretch. REFUSE TO BEND (IRE) broke slowly, was rank along the inside early, saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. DECARCHY settled three deep on the first turn and backstretch, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. PEACE RULES sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, dropped back in upper stretch and gave way.
