MONEY TALKER stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again on the second turn, came out in midstretch, bid alongside the runner-up under some urging in deep stretch, gained the lead late and gamely prevailed. TIZNOW OR THEN had speed outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace along the inside, fought back when challenged past midstretch and went on willingly to the wire. UNUSUAL BEAM chased outside a rival or off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch, was a bit crowded in midstretch and bested the others. SONG OF HONOR (GB) was a bit slow to begin and steadied when squeezed, pulled between horses then chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MR T BIRD stalked outside a rival or off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. COPPER BAY broke out onto a foe, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and did not rally. MIND THE MASTER pulled his way along inside, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, shifted in from the whip in midstretch and weakened. HARRY S. three deep into the first turn, settled off the rail, angled in on the second turn and lacked a further response.
