### Footnotes

HALF STRIKE had speed between foes then angled in, set the pace inside, inched away again into the second turn and won clear under urging. BIPARTISAN bobbled at the start, stalked just off the rail, advanced three deep leaving the second turn, loomed a threat behind the winner into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but held second. STARS AND MOONS kept four wide into the first turn, angled in on that bend, moved up inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the place. LITE THAT BABY UP chased outside a rival, continued outside on the backstretch and second turn, was a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DYLAN DONNELLY drifted out a bit into the first turn, chased off the rail, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BIO PRO stalked outside then off the rail, bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn, steadied into the stretch and weakened. SUANCESONG fanned five wide into the first turn, settled three deep chasing the pace and lacked a response in the stretch. SLEW'S FLASH steadied between horses into the first turn, settled between foes, angled in on the second turn and was not a threat. RYE WHISKEY pulled his way into a bit of a tight spot into the first turn, chased inside then between foes leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, dropped back on that turn and gave way.
