VALTARI stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the backstretch, bid between foes into and on the second turn then outside the winner through the lane, gained a short lead late under urging and gamely prevailed. SNAPS sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not quite contain the winner late. THUNDER COLE broke out and a bit awkwardly, chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. AIRFOIL stalked inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. CITRON KID angled in and settled a bit off the rail then came out off heels leaving the first turn, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, was momentarily in a bit tight off heels into the second turn and lacked the needed rally in the stretch. NAVARRE (GB) sent along inside then pulled and steadied in tight in midstretch the first time, came off the rail on the first turn, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch, bid three deep into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ADAMOR between foes early, angled in and chased inside, dropped back on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and gave way.
