**Footnotes**

PURIM'S DANCER stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid under left handed urging alongside the runner-up in deep stretch and wore down that foe. MISS LADY ELLEN had speed between foes then angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, came a bit off the fence again in the stretch, fought back when challenged in deep stretch but could not quite match the winner late. OSCILLATOR pulled outside early then went between horses on the hill, continued off the inside leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and bested the others. SWEET BAGUETTE broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the hill and three wide into the stretch, came out again in upper stretch and improved position. GRANNY CALLING saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. ENGLISH RHYTHM broke a bit slowly, settled just off the inside, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. WARREN'S MO MONEY broke through the gate before the start, settled outside then chased alongside a rival, angled in leaving the hill and lacked a further response. METAXA chased a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and weakened. FLORACITA had speed between foes then stalked three and four wide on the hill, dropped back outside then three wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong, was unsaddled a pole from the wire but walked off. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
