Footnotes

KAAACHING, forced the early pace three deep, dueled outside a rival on the turn, gained the lead in the stretch and inched clear under urging. BRITTHADIF, wide early, angled in for the turn, moved up inside into the stretch, came out past midstretch and finished well. FREE COMPANION, dueled between rivals on the backstretch and along the inside on the turn, then weakened in the final furlong but held third. SLEWREEN, settled off the rail, split

horses on the backstretch, came five wide into the stretch with a late bid. KID SISTER, settled off the inside, was three deep on the turn and lacked the needed rally. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER, steadied when squeezed at the start, angled in leaving the backstretch, steadied again off heels into the turn and improved position inside in the stretch. ESCONCE, forced the early pace four wide, stalked outside a foe on the turn and weakened. DIXIE LOE, steadied when squeezed at the start, was outrun off the rail to the stretch and was not a threat. HER REALITY, a bit crowded at the start, angled in leaving the backstretch, steadied briefly off heels into the turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. HIDE THE SILVER, a bit slow to begin, went up to prompt the pace between horses, found the inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch. HIGHER, sprinted up inside to press the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. A. P. MONEY settled off the inside, came five wide into the stretch and dropped back.
