SULTRY SOUND was sent up inside to duel for the lead, inched away down the hill, kicked clear in the stretch and held under left handed urging. FAST GOAT settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and finished fast. PRISSMAS chased outside early, split rivals on the hill, also came four wide crossing the dirt and into the stretch and picked up the show. CHEZ LA FEMME had speed between horses to duel for the lead, stalked a bit off the rail leaving the hill and weakened some in the stretch. GENTLE MIND pulled between foes early, angled in and stalked inside down the hill and lacked the needed late kick. SUMMERTIME FUN unhurried off the rail down the hill, split foes nearing the stretch and improved position. KYLIE'S ART bobbled at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out a bit into the stretch, was crowded off heels in upper stretch and lacked the necessary response. ILHA GRANDE hesitated to be off slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. VIOLINS unhurried outside down the hill, came widest into the stretch and was not a threat. WILSHEWED forced the early pace three deep, stalked outside on the hill and weakened in the stretch. CHARM CITY HEROINE close up outside early, dropped back four wide on the hill, angled in nearing the stretch and gave way.
