CONVEYOR'S ANGEL stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and pulled clear under some left handed urging while drifting in. ZAIN LASS chased inside then outside the winner early on the second turn, continued just off the rail, came out in upper stretch and rallied for the place. WISE INVESTOR close up stalking the pace while saving ground to the stretch, remained inside and bested the others. ELEVENTH STREET sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, inched away again leaving the second turn, battled inside the winner in midstretch, then weakened in the final furlong. EXCUSABULL angled to the inside and pulled a bit early, came off the rail and prompted the pace outside a foe then stalked off the rail, re-bid between foes into the second turn but weakened in the stretch. BERTRANDO'S BABE stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back leaving that bend and had little left for the stretch.
